World Powerlifting Championships Pump Up Palm Beach County

Palm Beach Gardens, FL-The Palm Beach County Sports Commission is teaming up with the World Powerlifting Federation to host the 2011 World Powerlifting Championship at the Palm Beach Gardens Marriott on November 8-13. The event attracts over 400 lifters from more than 20 different countries. The competition will crown champions in the following divisions: bench press, deadlift, and a combination of all lifts. Lifters will be assigned to a variety of age groups, including: juniors (13-16), juniors (17-18), adult (20-23), open (up to 40), masters (40 and over), and Special Olympics.

Previous World Powerlifting Championships have taken place all over the globe. In 2010, the event took place in Bath England while Las Vegas was the home in 2009. Other recent hosts included Austria, Mexico, and Germany.

"We are excited about bringing this international event to Palm Beach County", says David Jeffrey, President, United States Powerlifting Federation. "The great climate, culture and pristine beaches offer a great place for participants and spectators to enjoy."

The World Powerlifting Championships is bringing more than \$350,000 in economic impact to Palm Beach County and over 1,000 room nights.
