The value of his in-kind services is over \$150,000 and when added to his recommendations for reducing construction costs, he has literally saved this not-for-profit hundreds of thousands of dollars.

Mr. Clifford’s passion for the infrastructure, design and purpose of these buildings was unyielding. Bill could be found at the construction site on a daily basis. Sleeves rolled up – there was no job too small and none too large. Mr. Clifford’s hands-on approach included raising a significant amount of financial contributions which helped finance this construction endeavor.
