

Go Blue to End Mean Campaign

AIM: To engage raise awareness of bullying among girls, and **Make it a team effort.** Include the entire school: principals, teachers; students, parents, families, and PTA.

MATERIALS: blue wall board, poster board, paint markers (light colors), pens, or paint

AGES: 8-17

TIME: Any day during Anti-Bullying Week

WALL OF NICE:

Instructions: Create blue awareness ribbons. Display posters in school. Create "a Wall of Nice" for an area where bullying takes place or other prominent location. Pick to a day during Anti-bullying Week and invite everyone to wear something blue in solidarity and hang out ribbons.



THE BLUE PINKY PROJECT:

Participating in the project is simple: Pick a day to carry out the "Pinky Promise". Promote painting your pinky blue through social media, announcements and Got Blue Pinkies posters to stand in solidarity to stand up to bullying. Hand out awareness ribbons on the day
