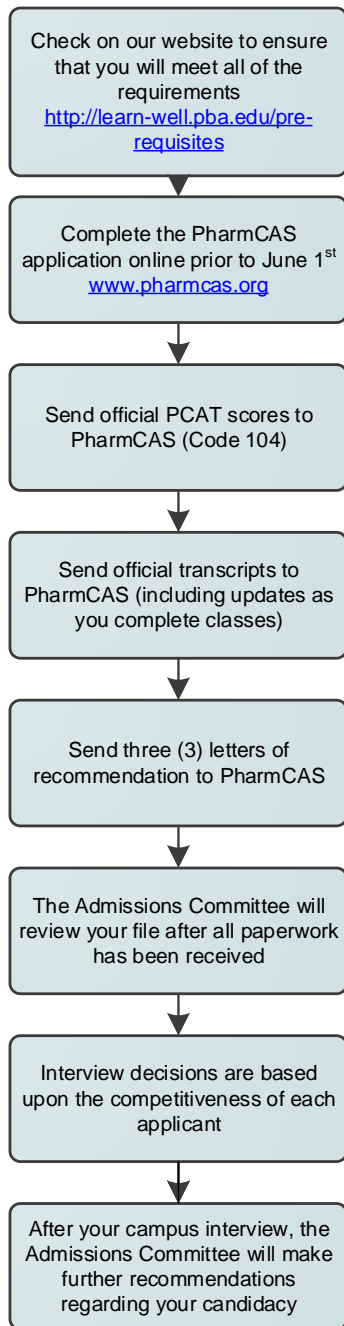


**Pharmacy Application Process Diagram**

**You MUST Complete These Steps to Apply:**

1. Check out Palm Beach Atlantic’s Lloyd L. Gregory School of Pharmacy website to ensure that you have a plan to complete the required courses prior to the Fall term that you are applying for:

(Any exceptions to explicit admissions criteria will be made on a case-by-case basis. It will be up to an Admissions Committee to make any such decisions.)
2. Apply online using PharmCAS (Pharmacy College Application Service) at <http://www.pharmcas.org/>. The PharmCAS application deadline is June 1<sup>st</sup>.
3. Send all of the necessary application documents directly to PharmCAS for verification. This should include: transcripts, [PCAT scores](#), and Letters of Recommendation. (Note: You do not need all of these documents prior to starting your application.)
4. Once Steps 1 through 3 have been completed, and all the documents have been received, the Admissions Committee will review your file for eligibility for a campus interview. The Gregory School of Pharmacy at Palm Beach Atlantic University is a competitive program; therefore, we are not able to grant interviews to every applicant. We limit enrollment to approximately 75 students each academic year.
5. After your campus interview has been conducted, the Admissions Committee will review your file to make a decision/recommendation on your candidacy.
6. After an offer of acceptance is received, you have two (2) weeks to formally accept the offer by submitting a deposit of \$750 to Pharmacy Admissions. A final deposit of \$250 is due by June 1<sup>st</sup>. If you receive an offer of acceptance after July 15th, a payment of \$1,000 is due within two weeks of receiving the offer.
