- a. SITE PLAN AND LANDSCAPE PLAN REVIEW AT 51 COUNTRY ROAD SOUTH; The Gollinger's at 51 Country Road South are requesting permission to add a swimming pool to their home. The pool will sit on the east side of the property, about 40 feet south of the golf course, double the required setback. The Gollinger's are proposing extensive landscaping, including a 5-foot hedge and several additional layers of landscaping to screen the pool from view of the golf course and protect the property from stray golf balls. ARC has reviewed the plans and recommends approval.
