

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA; ADOPTING AN UPDATED SCHEDULE OF RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE RENDERED BY THE VILLAGE OF GOLF FOR ITS CITIZENS AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC; PROVIDING THAT THIS SCHEDULE OF RATES, FEES AND CHARGES SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION AT ALL TIMES AT VILLAGE HALL DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf operates a water and sewer utility system; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf Water Utility rates, fees and charges may be amended from time to time as necessary by Resolution of the Village Council; and was most recently amended by Resolution No. 2017-01 on January 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf has reviewed its water utility data which indicates that the Village's Water Utility rates, fees and charges should be amended by adopting a new, updated schedule of fees and charges to maintain the fiscal integrity of the Water Utility; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to make certain the schedule of utility service rates, fees and charges is available for inspection such that any member of the public may be aware of the cost of utility services provided by the Village of Golf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1: The Village Council of the Village of Golf hereby officially adopts a new updated schedule of rates, fees and charges attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as is fully set forth herein.

Section 2: This Resolution specifically supersedes and repeals any and all other schedules of utility service rates, fees, charges and/or surcharges previously adopted, specifically including Resolution No. 2017-01; however, all other provisions set forth in Resolution No 08-03, as amended by Resolution No. 2016-03, concerning the Village's Uniform Water and Sewer Policy shall remain in full force and effect except for those matters specifically set forth on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect October 1, 2017.
