A wire enclosure to contain all refuse and debris is to be maintained from the beginning of the job until completion. All discarded materials must be placed in this enclosure. Debris shall be emptied periodically during construction and not allowed to build up. If, after notification in writing, material is not periodically cleaned up and hauled away, the Village may enter upon the property and have the material removed and bill the property owner for charges incurred.

Remove all mud and loose concrete from the roadway leading to and from the house. Protect the road and curbing by use of Shell Rock.

Repair and re-sod all areas on adjacent or other property torn up or damaged during construction. Provide adequate protection against drainage of water from the construction site on to adjacent or other areas. If the contractor and/or owner fails to comply with the above, the Village may enter upon such areas/property and complete the repair and re-sodding. The cost of such work will be charged by the Village after grass is established.

Delivery trucks of concrete, block, sod and other materials MUST KEEP OFF PROPERTY, OTHER THAN THAT OF THE OWNER. THIS ALSO APPLIES TO PARKING BY SUB-CONTRACTORS AND LABORERS. No concrete truck shall wash out his truck or empty excess materials on any lot, except on the lot where construction is taking place.

All portable toilets shall be a minimum of 35 feet from the edge of the road and shielded from view from the road.
