I. Mission and Purpose

The mission of the Lung Cancer Initiative of North Carolina (LCI) is to save lives and provide support to those affected by lung cancer through research, awareness, education and access programs across North Carolina.

Innovation in Lung Cancer Research Award: The Innovation in Lung Cancer Award recognizes and supports researchers and collaborations aimed toward developing innovative lung cancer projects that will improve the lives of those at risk of or with lung cancer in North Carolina.

The award is granted for one year. The stipend is \$25,000.

III. Eligibility Criteria

The Innovation in Lung Cancer Research Award is open to researchers of all levels and at all institutions and companies across the state of North Carolina. Researchers who have received funding from LCI in the past are not eligible to apply.

The project must be focused on one of the following in lung cancer: prevention, diagnosis, treatment or survivorship.

Projects that are collaborative are strongly encouraged.

V. Post-Award Requirements

Applicants will be required to submit a final progress report and present at a Lung Cancer Initiative meeting within one year of project completion.
